Lois Emily Yager, age 82, of Spirit Lake, passed away Saturday, April 5, 2014, at Hilltop Care Center in Spirit Lake. She was born on February 21, 1932, in Lansing, Iowa, to Robert and Ella (Miles) Cooper. Lois spent her childhood living in Backbone State Park, where she and her brother spent their days exploring the park, fishing for trout, raising horses, goats and raccoons.

In 1948, Lois moved to spirit Lake, where she met the love of her life! On March 27, 1951, she was united in marriage to Duane Yager in Jackson, Minnesota. Lois worked as the Deputy City Clerk in Spirit Lake for 32 years, before retiring in 1997.
