Arnold "Arnie" McIntosh, 76, of Spirit Lake passed away on Friday, July 14, 2023, at Lakes Regional Health Care in Spirit Lake.

Arnold Dwight McIntosh was born on August 15, 1946, to David and Opal (Fountain) McIntosh in Council Bluffs, IA. He graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School in Council Bluffs and studied electronics at a trade school in Omaha, NE. He devoted his entire professional career to the phone companies of Northwestern Bell, Qwest, USWest and Telec and he loved what he did.

He was united in marriage to Judy Barber on November 13, 1965, in Council Bluffs, IA.

Arnie was a long-time standing member of the RLDS Church and in his later years converted to practice the Catholic Faith. Arnie volunteered many hours for the Jaycees Organization, St. Albert High School, Youth for Understanding, Helping Hands and multiple other organizations. He also was a Toast Master, a lifetime member of the Telephone Pioneer Association, and served as the

President of the East Okoboji Beach Association for 10 years.

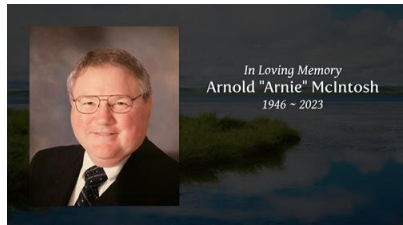
