



Arnold "Fred" Schroeter

September 22, 1932 - February 9, 2013

Arnold F. Schroeter, age 80, of Spirit Lake, passed away on Saturday, February 9, 2013, at Hilltop Care Center in Spirit Lake. He was born on September 22, 1932, in Lindsey, Nebraska, to Gustav and Martha (Leder) Schroeter.

Fred attended the University of Nebraska, before owning and operating Diesel Specialties. He started the company in 1964, and has owned it ever since. Fred was a member of the Association of Diesel Specialists, where he served as past president and a past board member. He served his country in the United States Army.
