Helen Adele Jensen (Rasmussen), age 95, of Okoboji, IA, passed away on Wednesday, December 30, 2015, at her home in Okoboji. She was born on June 23, 1920, in Omaha, NE, to Harry and Hattie (Hillesland) Rasmussen. She grew up as a farm girl near Inwood, Iowa, and after graduating from high school, she earned her teaching certificate at Iowa State Teacher's College in Cedar Falls. She began her teaching career in Sutherland, where she met John Jensen, whom she married on August 1, 1945.

She continued her teaching career while raising her family with John. She attended post-graduate education at Augustana College (Sioux Falls) for her Bachelor's degree, and then graduated with her Master's degree from the University of South Dakota. She first taught elementary grades, and for the last half of her career she was a reading and learning disabilities specialist. She loved working with children, and was once named "Iowa's Outstanding Elementary Teacher of the Year." Her last several years of teaching were in Arnolds Park.

Helen enjoyed oil painting, reading, flowers, gardening, and family fun.
