James "Jim" Hale Burgeson "Burgy" passed away on Wednesday, October 18 at the age of 85, in Milford, IA. His battle and determination with medical issues in the recent years showed his courage and love for his family.

Jim was confirmed in the Presbyterian church in Holdrege, NE. He was very proud of the Sunday school pins he received for perfect attendance. He was a member of Calvary United Methodist church in Arnolds Park, IA. He knew his Lord Jesus Christ and said he was the closest to God when out on the lake. Jim's love of racing never left his blood, passing that love down to his children and grandchildren. The memories made by that pastime were often visited. His other love was definitely fishing.
