Laurel Fae Horsman (1931-2020)

Laurel Fae Horsman, 89, formerly of Wahpeton and Laurens, passed away on Saturday, October 17, 2020 at Community Healthcare in Hartley. A private family burial for Fae and her husband, the late Robert Horsman who preceded her in death in 2011, will be held in the Powhatan Cemetery in rural Rolfe, IA.
