Mabel Janis Anderson Kruse, 96, of Spirit Lake passed away on Tuesday, February 11, 2020 at the Lakes Regional Healthcare of Spirit Lake. Memorial services for Janis will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, February 14, 2020 at the United Methodist Church in Spirit Lake.

Janis was born on December 24, 1923 in Estherville, IA to Clarence W. and Martha Blanche (Klinepeter) Anderson. She graduated from Gruver High School in 1942.
