Pamela “Pam” Kragt, 77, of Cedar Falls, passed away on Thursday, January 2, 2025, at Nation Cottage at Western Home Communities in Cedar Falls, IA. Pamela Kae Kragt was born on March 12, 1947, in Primghar, IA, to Arlington Ferdinand and Rosa Mae (Green) Ericson. She graduated from Sioux City Central High School and went on to earn a degree in education from Morningside College in Sioux City, IA. She was crowned Miss Sioux City and Miss Iowa in 1966 and went on to compete in the Miss America pageant. She was united in marriage to Dr. John B. Kragt on December 16, 1983, in Emmetsburg, IA. Pam began her career as a teacher in Havelock, IA, was a bookkeeper at West Bend International and later was the office manager for John’s Chiropractic Business in Emmetsburg, Iowa. 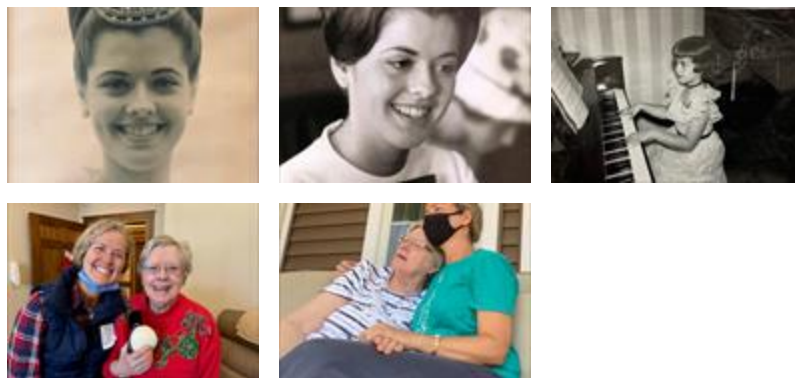
