



## Roger Dean Botine

December 18, 1940 - October 26, 2016

Roger Dean Botine, 75, of West Okoboji, formerly of Storm Lake, passed away on Wednesday, October 26, 2016 at Lakes Regional Healthcare in Spirit Lake. Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. at First Lutheran Church in West Okoboji on Saturday, October 29, 2016 with Rev. Perry Aalgaard and Rev. Bob Vaage officiating. Burial will be in the Buena Vista Memorial Park Cemetery in Storm Lake, IA. Visitation will be on Friday from 6-8 p.m. at the Schuchert-Lentz Funeral Home in Spirit Lake. Roger was born on December 18, 1940 in Storm Lake, IA to August and Anna (Kramer) Botine. He graduated from Storm Lake High School and attended Dunwoody Institute. He was united in marriage to Elaine Spooner on October 16, 1960 at St. Marks Lutheran Church in Storm Lake, IA. He owned and operated Botine Electric Inc. in Storm Lake for many years. During his time in Storm Lake, he was also the Mayor of Lakeside for 10 years. Roger and Elaine moved to Spirit Lake after he suffered a heart attack in 1995. After getting on his feet again, he began working for Fisherman's Factory Outlet and Elaine worked for Fareway in Spirit Lake for 15 years.

He was a member of First Lutheran Church in West Okoboji. He was the Area and Zone Chairman for Ducks Unlimited for the North West Iowa area. He enjoyed hunting and fishing. Spending time with family was very important to Roger. He treasured the time he took his grandchildren on picnics. He also

enjoyed cooking for his friends.

Roger is survived by his wife Elaine Botine of West Okoboji; son David Botine of West Okoboji; daughter Ann Marie Botine of Milford; 4 grandchildren January, Dean, Abigayle, and Jessica; 5 great grandchildren Gabrielle, Madison, Elijah, Jace, JJ and one on the way; and one brother Richard (Pat) Botine of Storm Lake.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

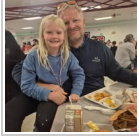
