Roy H. Wiegert, 87, of Spirit Lake passed away on Friday, September 18, 2020 at Lakes Regional Healthcare in Spirit Lake. There will be a private family burial in the Lake View Cemetery in Spirit Lake.

Roy H. Wiegert, the son of George and Doris Wiegert, was born June 30, 1933 on the family farm southwest of Gilmore City. He graduated from Gilmore City High School. He attended Iowa State University and graduated from the University of Iowa. He also was a member of ROTC and received a commission as Second Lieutenant. He continued his education at Emporia State Teachers College where he received a Master of Library Science degree.

On June 10, 1956, he married Linda Andersen of Humboldt. Upon graduation from the U of I, Roy was assigned to teach at the missile school at Fort Sill, OK. He then went on to teach 7th grade in Clarksville, IA and then social studies in Mallard, IA. While pursuing his library degree at the U of I, he was offered the job as head of the library at the high school and junior college in Keokuk, IA. With the advent of the area community college, he was hired by the Iowa Lakes Community College in Estherville, IA to head the Learning Resource Center with responsibility at all sites, retiring in 1995. He enjoyed teaching and fishing in Canada.

He is survived by his wife of 64 years, Linda, of Spirit Lake; two children, Cheryl Taylor of Buford, GA; Edmond (Jean) Wiegert of Charlotte, NC; and grandson James Roy Taylor of Buford, GA. He is also survived by his brother-in-law, Steven (Sandi) Andersen, nephews Allen (Sandy) of Storm Lake, IA; Devlin Andersen, niece Collette (Daryl) Sternitzke, a grandniece and 3 grandnephews. He was preceded in death by his parents.
