Sharon Rose “Kinniston” Caskey, 85, peacefully passed away at home on Monday, March 31, 2025, surrounded by family and friends.

Services for Sharon and her son, Curtis Caskey, 58, of Sioux City, who preceded her in death on March 16, 2025, will be held at 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 2, 2025, at the First Presbyterian Church in Spirit Lake.
