Steven L. Wallace, age 57, of Spirit Lake, passed away Friday, January 23, 2015, at his home in Spirit Lake. He was born on February 3, 1957, in Spirit Lake, to Leonard and Melba (Hilliard) Wallace.

Steve graduated from Spirit Lake High School in 1975. He was united in marriage to Judy Gerstandt on May 7, 1978, in Spirit Lake. Steve worked for Wedeking Construction for many years and helped his uncle, Dean Wallace farm. In 1992, he continued Dean's legacy and has been proud to operate the Wallace Family Farm since.
