Thomas C. Barfoot, age 66, of Spirit Lake, passed away on Tuesday, March 4, 2014, at his home in Spirit Lake. He was born on November 25, 1947, in Estherville, Iowa, to Robert H. and Bette J. (Beck) Barfoot.

Tom graduated from Estherville High School and Iowa Lakes Community College. He worked in the kitchen at The Inn in Okoboji, and Fagre Construction in Estherville.
